## Please Join Us in January and Share YOUR Work!

We are excited to announce our first IN PERSON Annual Meeting since 2019, to be held Friday January 27, 2023 at UCSF's Mission Bay Conference Center. The conference theme is "Reimagining Community Research Partnerships in a World Transformed by COVID-19", and our goal is to examine the COVID-19 pandemic from several perspectives to arrive at identify lessons that can help us advance community research partnerships in ways that are more equitable and impactful. Featured speakers will include UCSF's Peter Chin-Hong, Erica Pan (California's State Epidemiologist), as well as leaders from important community initiatives such as Umoja Health, STOP COVID, the Fresno COVID-19 Health Equity Project, and school health experts from Oakland and San Francisco School Districts. The meeting this year will be cosponsored by UCSF's Impacting Practice and Policy by Accelerating Translation (IMPACT) Program.

## **HERE with Community Project**

In 2021, SFBayCRN was awarded a health equity research grant from the Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI) to understand the perceptions and needs of community health center leaders and their patients related to COVID-19 research. We are grateful to the **San Francisco Community Clinic Consortium**, the **Benioff Children's Hospital in Oakland**, the **Family Health Care Network** in the Central Valley for their partnership on this project. Preliminary findings will be shared at our January meeting, followed by a **Town Hall** to discuss opportunities to move the agenda forward as the pandemic continues to evolve and require new initiatives.
